With WriteToLearn, students practice essay writing and summarization skills, and their efforts are measured by the state-of-the-art Knowledge Analysis Technologies™ (KAT) engine, developed by Pearson's Knowledge Technologies group. The KAT engine is a unique automated assessment technology that evaluates the meaning of text, not just grammatical correctness or spelling. Students receive immediate, specific feedback on their work, and teachers easily assess student efforts individually or as a class, in real time.

Using WriteToLearn, students develop a skill that good readers naturally possess – the ability to summarize what they read. They practice essay writing and summarizing and build both writing and reading comprehension skills across the curriculum.

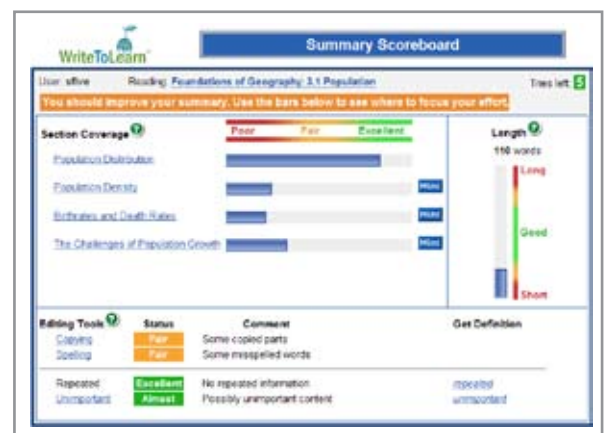
WriteToLearn offers students:
